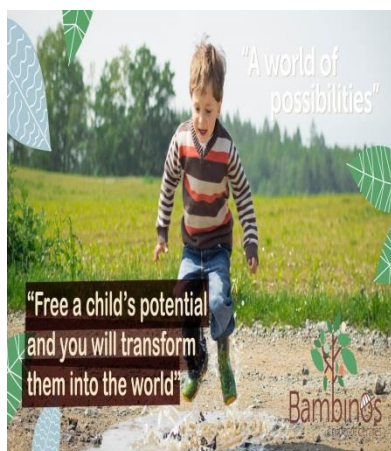


Share a story!

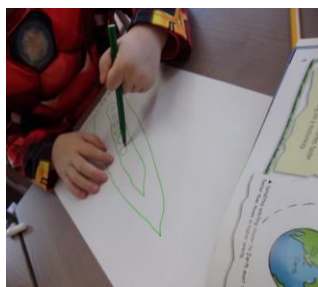
Summer Term - 22nd April - 26th July 2019

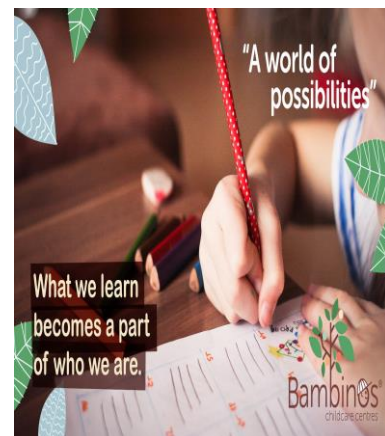
We also had lots of fun taking part in the Easter stay and play along with the Easter egg hunt in April.
